Dr. Pawlowski graduated from UC Davis in 1996 and began working with Banfield. He quickly became the chief of staff and mentor doctor for the Sacramento region. In October 2002, he and his wife, opened their first Banfield hospital in Folsom. In 2007, they opened their second Banfield in Lincoln. With a team of more than 20 - including veterinarians, RVT's, petnurses and receptionists - they provide medical care to dogs, cats, rabbits, ferrets, birds, rodents, reptiles and even Sugar Gliders!

Prior to going to veterinary school Dr. Pawlowski earned a degree in Exotic Animal Training and Management from the famous EATM program at Moorpark College and subsequently trained sea lions and dolphins for the US Navy (as a civilian) in San Diego.
