We can usually be set up to shelter cats and pocket pets within a matter of hours of the initial call for help. Our priorities are the safety and comfort of the animals we are caring for and offering compassion to their owners. As cat experts, we know how to make even the most fearful cats feel relatively comfortable in a shelter setting.

We have veterinary staff onsite as needed. When extended care is necessary, we utilize full-service veterinary clinics in the area.
