Welcome to Meow & Forever Rehoming Program

All of us at FieldHaven Feline Center are excited to help you rehome your cat. Now that you've completed the application, **what happens next?**

A volunteer will contact you **within 3-4 business days** after reviewing your application to be sure everything is complete. If it is, your cat will be posted on our website along with all the other adoptable cats & kittens. Once your cat is posted, the work begins. You will be provided with a direct link to your cat's posting you can use to spread the word about finding a home. Post to Facebook, Instagram, Next Door, Craig's List. Email your contacts. The idea is to **network, network, network.**

We recommend joining our **FieldHaven Alumni Facebook group**. This group page is usually reserved for photos and posts about cats adopted from FieldHaven, but as part of Meow & Forever, you may post your "future alumni." Post new pictures and videos of your cat and use the hashtags **#Meow&Forever**, **#FutureFieldHavenAlumni**, and **#AdoptDontShop**. Always include the link to the online listing. As part of Meow & Forever, we will share your posts to adoption sites as our resources permit. Good photos are important. There are several YouTube videos on how to take quality cat photos. You can even get tips from the members of FieldHaven Alumni. Videos are great, too. We recommend that they be about **30 - 45 seconds long**. You can do multiple clips, but keep them short and cute. You want prospective adopters to get engaged with your cat through photos and video so they will want to meet them.

When someone is interested in meeting your cat, set up a meet-up time. If you aren't comfortable with meeting at your home, arrangements can be made for you to meet at FieldHaven. Your volunteer contact will coordinate it with you. We look forward to working with you to find the very best home for your kitty!
